Special and Emergency Board Meetings

Special meetings may be convened by order of the President, upon request of three Board members or by common consent of the Board members. The Board secretary will post notice at least 3 working days before the meeting convenes. –

The purpose of special meetings is to give the Board an opportunity to gather information, to discuss and fully explore various aspects of an issue or to address time sensitive items in a timely manner rather than waiting for a full month.

Emergency meetings may be called only in the event of an actual emergency. Appropriate notice will be given to the public and the press. The minutes of the meeting will describe the nature of the emergency. No business other than that related to the emergency will be discussed at these meetings.
