

Orientation of New Board Members

A new member is to be given the Board's and staff's fullest measure of courtesy and cooperation. Board and staff will make every effort to assist the new member to become fully informed about the Board's functions, policies, procedures and issues. In the interim between election and assuming office or following appointment, the new Board member(s) will be assisted in the following ways:

1. The newly elected or appointed Board member may be given materials on the role of a Board member;
2. The newly elected Board member may be invited to attend Board meetings to observe the operation of the Board until he/she assumes office in January;
3. The newly elected or appointed Board member may be given a copy of Board policies, Board priorities, long-range plans and district-adopted budget;
4. The members of the Board may serve as mentors to newly elected or appointed Board members;
5. The superintendent may supply material pertinent to meetings and will explain its content;
6. The newly elected or appointed Board member may be invited to meet with the superintendent and other administrative personnel, by arrangement with the superintendent, to discuss services they perform for the district;
7. The newly elected or appointed Board member may be encouraged to attend the Board Conference and the Leadership Academy sponsored by the Nevada Association of School Boards;
8. The newly elected Board member may receive all reports and communications normally sent to Board members.
