Hazardous Threats

If a call or notice that a hazardous device or substance has been placed in a school or any other building is received, the superintendent or designee may consider the following:

1. Evacuation;
2. Immediate notification to the fire and/or law enforcement departments unless the call was originally received by these departments;
3. Searching of the premises with direction from a law enforcement officers or firefighters;
4. Removal procedures of any “strange” or foreign object with direction from a law enforcement officers or firefighters;
5. Reentry procedures if evacuation has occurred;
6. Investigation by local law enforcement assisted by state fire marshal’s office if requested.

Any decision concerning students’ dismissal and subsequent action after the above procedures have been followed are the superintendent’s or designee’s prerogative.
