

SCHOOL BUS DRIVER HOURS

A driver's hours shall be regulated from the time a driver reports for duty for the employer as outlined:

1. The driver of a school bus shall not drive more than ten hours within a work period, or
2. Drive after fifteen consecutive hours have elapsed since first reporting for duty.

School Bus Driver Hours (Exceptions)

1. Adverse conditions. A driver may be permitted to drive for more than the regulated hours if the excess hours are due to snow, sleet, rain, fog, or adverse weather, road, or traffic conditions.
2. Emergencies. In the event of a traffic accident, medical emergency, or disaster, a driver may complete the trip if the trip could be reasonably completed under normal conditions without exceeding the regulated hours.
