Credit by Apprenticeship Training Program, Work Study and Cooperative Education

Credit for apprenticeship training, work study and cooperative education programs may be granted to students enrolled in high schools in Lincoln County School District. Except for special circumstances, students should be in the 11th or 12th grade.

All programs for apprenticeship, work study and cooperative education must be established through the appropriate high school principal. The principal is responsible to allow or disallow any individual program based on the educational value of that program. The site principal is also responsible to coordinate with the employer to establish communication regarding attendance, grading, and any other school concerns.

One-fourth credit for 65 hours of work will be granted for cooperative education classes. Only five credits can be utilized towards graduation under cooperative education and associated programs. (Cooperative education credit does not qualify students for athletics.)

A student may be enrolled for no more than two school periods in cooperative education during the school day.

A pass/fail grade will be given for student aides and cooperative education.
