Special Education - Evaluation Procedures

A full and individual evaluation of a student's educational needs will be conducted before determining eligibility and before the initial provision of special education and related services to a student with a disability. Testing and evaluation materials and procedures will be selected and administered so as not to be racially or culturally discriminatory. A student must meet the eligibility criteria established in the Nevada Administrative Regulations to qualify for special education.

A reevaluation will be conducted every three years or more frequently if conditions warrant or if the student's parent(s) or teacher requests an evaluation.

All procedures will be retained in a handbook consistent with the policies and procedures as approved by, and on file with, the Lincoln County School District.
