High School Classes/Courses for Seventh or Eighth Graders

The district encourages students to perform at the highest level possible in their course work. Recognizing that some upper level elementary school age students are able to master existing high school curriculum, it is the policy of the district to allow seventh or eighth grade students, who are qualified, to take designated high school classes/courses. High school credit may be granted, if students taking pre-grade nine courses are required to meet performance criteria that are equivalent to the performance criteria for students taking the same high school classes, and if teachers of those courses possess secondary certification to teach these courses.

Credit will be granted when the student enrolls in the ninth grade.
