School Attendance Areas

Attendance areas are established by the administration and approved by the Board for all elementary, middle school and high school buildings in the district. Boundaries are set for attendance areas so that students can be given the best possible education at the lowest possible cost.

Defined attendance areas reduce overcrowding in one building to provide fuller use of space and personnel in another building. The superintendent is directed to monitor student flow into and out of all buildings, and to make adjustments as needed. All changes in school attendance areas should benefit the total school program educationally and financially.

School Attendance Area Descriptions

Attendance areas are as follows:

Caliente Elementary

All kindergarten through sixth grade students living in the area bounded by a North/South line through mile marker 78 (US 93) on the West, an East/West line through mile marker 103 (US 93) on the North, the Nevada/Utah border on the east. The southern boarder will be an East/West line following 37 Degrees 20 Minutes North Latitude from the Nevada/Utah border to the Cane Spring Road then along the Cane Spring Road to the intersection of the East/West line through mile marker 78.

Coyote Springs Elementary

All kindergarten through fifth grade students living in the area bounded by the Lincoln/Nye County line on the West, the Lincoln/Clark line on the South, and the Meadow Valley Wash on the East. The Northern border will be an East/West line following 37 Degrees 20 Minutes North Latitude from the Meadow Valley Wash to the Cane Spring Road then the Cane Spring Road to the intersection of the Cane Spring Road and US 93, then an East/West line to the Lincoln/Nye County border.

Pahranagat Valley Elementary

All kindergarten through fifth grade students living in the area bounded by the Lincoln/Nye County line on the North starting at the western most north corner and continuing to the east until it hits the north/south line through mile marker 78 on US 93. The Eastern boundary will be the North/South line through mile marker 78 on US 93. The southern boundary will be the Kane Springs Road on the east side of US 93 and an East/West line from the junction of US 93 and the Cane Spring Road on the west side of US 93. The Western boundary will be the Lincoln/Nye County line.

Panaca Elementary

All kindergarten through sixth grade students living in the area bounded by an east/west line through mile marker 103 on US 93 on the south, a north/south line through mile marker 78 on US 93 on the east, the Nevada/Utah border on the east, and an east/west line through mile marker 113 on US 93 on the north.

Pioche Elementary

All kindergarten through sixth grade students living in the area bounded by an east/west line through mile marker 103 on US 93 on the south, the Nevada/Utah border on the east, the Lincoln/White Pine County line on the north, and the Lincoln/Nye County Line on the east until the Lincoln/Nye County line runs east and west. At that point the eastern boundary will be the north/south line through mile marker 78 on US 93.

Toquop Elementary

All kindergarten through 5th grade students living in the area bounded by the Nevada/Utah border on the east, the Lincoln/Clark County border on the south, the Meadow Valley Wash on the West, and a line along 37 Degrees 20 Minutes North Latitude on the North.

Coyote Springs Middle School

All 6 - 8 grade students living in the Coyote Springs Elementary area.

Meadow Valley Middle School

All 7 - 8 grade students living in the Caliente, Panaca and Pioche Elementary areas.

Pahrnagat Valley Middle School

All 6 – 8 grade students living in the Pahrnagat Valley Elementary area.

Toquop Middle

All 6 – 8 grade students living in the Toquop Elementary area.

Coyote Springs High School

All 9 – 12 grade students living in the Coyote Springs Elementary area

Lincoln County High School

All 9 – 12 grade students living in the Caliente, Panaca and Pioche Elementary areas.

Pahrnagat Valley High School

All 9 – 12 grade students living in the Pahrnagat Valley Elementary area.

Toquop High School

All 9 - 12 grade students living in the Toquop Elementary area

C.O. Bastian High School

All students referred to Caliente Youth Center by the courts of Nevada.
