Admissions

The Board is committed to providing an educational program for all students living in the district. The Board believes all students living in the district who have not completed 12 years of education should attend school regularly and be included in the available educational programs.

State law requires students to be age six on or before September 30 to enter first grade; and age five on or before September 30 to enter kindergarten.

All new students must register in the office. Registration requirements include proof of the student's birth date (a birth certificate, a hospital record or a baptismal record) and immunization records as required by law. Students admitted to any grade must show evidence of completing the prior school years.

Students enrolled in the district shall comply with Nevada laws related to age, residence, health and immunization.

Students located in the district shall not be excluded from admission solely because the student does not have a fixed place of residence or solely because the student is not under the supervision of a parent. However, Lincoln County Adult High School is the only option for students not under the supervision of a parent.

Adult students 18 years old may be admitted to one of the two juvenile public high schools in LCSD, but must be willing to submit to all juvenile requirements that apply to all juvenile students in LCSD. Adult students are not allowed to enroll themselves. A parent or legal guardian must be present.

Adult students that are 19 years old may be admitted to one of the two juvenile public high schools in LCSD, only if they have been continuously enrolled for three previous years of high school. The enrollment status of a 19 year old in one of the two juvenile public high schools in LCSD must be reviewed and approved by the building principal.

Adult students that are 20 years old are not admitted to a juvenile public high school in LCSD. Their educational services are provided by the Lincoln County Adult High School.
