Academic Probation for 8th Grade Students

A pupil who has completed eighth grade who has not completed all of the courses of study or credits required for promotion to high school by the State Board in English, mathematics, science and social studies shall be placed on academic probation and enrolled in high school. A ninth grade pupil who is on this academic probation shall complete appropriate remediation in the subject areas that he failed to pass. The student will remain on academic probation until all of the courses of study or credits required for promotion to high school by the State Board in English, mathematics, science, and social studies have been earned.

A parent or legal guardian may elect not to place his or her child on academic probation but to have the pupil remain in grade eight for a second year.

A student who is on academic probation shall not be permitted to try out or participate in any high school extra-curricular activities.

An eighth grade student who does not complete summer school, correspondence classes, or district provided remediation prior to enrolling in high school will not be eligible for academic probation under this policy, and will remain in grade eight for a second year.
