Laser Pens

Due to the potential for the disruption of the school environment and the risk of permanent eye damage, student use or possession of laser pens while on district property, while attending a district-sponsored activity on or off district property or while traveling to or from any school event is prohibited.

Any student found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, including the confiscation of the laser pen. Confiscated pens will be taken to the principal's office for the parents to retrieve.

Staff wishing to use laser pens for instructional purposes shall do so only with prior building administrator approval.
