Students on Probation or Parole

The fact that a student is on probation or parole shall not, in itself, be cause of or for any kind of special status or treatment. However, the records of such students should be carefully evaluated to determine whether there is reason to anticipate dangerous or disruptive behavior.

Any student enrolling who is on parole from a correctional institution or is on probation locally, shall be accepted, providing the principal has reviewed the record and determined that the student's behavior does not constitute an inordinate risk to the safety or orderly conduct of the school. The principal should cooperate fully with the institution and make use of the Counseling and Guidance Department and parole officer as needed in promptly reaching this determination.
