

Immunizations and Health Examinations

Proof of immunization must be presented prior to the time of initial enrollment in school. Proof consists of a signed Certificate of Immunization Status form documenting either evidence of immunization or a religious and/or medical exemption.

The Board recommends that all students initially enrolling in school have a physical examination. Parents will be asked to complete a district Health History form when initially enrolling their students in the district.

All students in grades 9-12 participating in athletic programs are required to submit to the district a School Sports Pre-participation Examination form prior to their initial participation in a district athletic program and prior to their 3rd year of participation. The form is to be completed and signed by a parent and physician giving permission for the student to participate.

A student who is subsequently diagnosed with a significant illness, injury or has had a major surgery is required to have a physical examination or a doctors release prior to further participation in extracurricular sports.
