Supervision of Students

The Board expects all students to be under assigned adult supervision when they are in school, traveling under school auspices or engaging in school-sponsored activities. Personnel assigned this supervision are expected to act as prudent adults in providing for the safety of students in their charge.

In keeping with this expected prudence, no teacher or other staff member will leave his/her assigned group unsupervised except in an emergency situation when other arrangements have been made.

During school hours, or while engaging in school-sponsored activities, students will be released only into the custody of parents or other persons who have been designated in writing, by the parents, prior to the trip.

Activities in Lincoln County School District are held to enhance the total educational program. To ensure the student's protection and comfort the activities shall be held where the district's insurance will be in effect and where the sponsor of the activity can have complete control of the premises.

Students of legal age (18 yrs. or older) enrolled in high school are not allowed to supervise themselves. Adult students enrolled in high school are also not allowed to supervise other students.
