Student Vehicle Use

All students who drive vehicles to school are subject to parking and driving rules developed by the school.

The district may require all students parking vehicles on district property on a regular basis to show evidence:

1. That the student driving the vehicle holds a valid driver's license;
2. That the vehicle is currently registered;
3. That the student driving is insured under a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or other satisfactory proof of compliance with the financial responsibility requirements of the state;

Parking privileges will be subject to the specific requirements of this policy and any other applicable policy and/or rules of the district. Parking privileges, including driving on district property, may be revoked by the building principal for violations of Board policies, administrative regulations or school rules.

Student Vehicle Use

The board of school trustees to insure the safety of our students, endorses and encourages strict compliance with the laws regulating traffic in school zones.

Rules regulating traffic on school property shall be as follows:

- A. speed limit 10 m.p.h.
- B. drivers shall at all times use extreme caution when operating vehicles on school property
- c. no school property shall be used as a thorough fare
- D. no unlicensed motor vehicles or motor bikes will be permitted on school property without the approval of the principal
- E. vehicles are to be driven only on designated areas unless otherwise authorized

The board of school trustees encourages and supports the enforcement of the above regulations by law enforcement agencies. Their right and obligation to enter school property for the purpose of enforcing the above and/or apprehending violators is duly recognized.
