

Use of Tobacco

As required in accordance with 20 USC §6084 (The Pro-Children Act of 1994) and NRS 202.2483 (Nevada Clean Indoor Act), the use of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes and similar products, is prohibited within any building owned, leased, contracted for and utilized by the District for the provision of kindergarten, elementary education, secondary education, or library services to children. This prohibition extends to any areas that are routinely or regularly used by District employees, including but not limited to: classrooms, work areas, restrooms, hallways, employee lounges, cafeterias, conference and meeting rooms, lobbies, reception areas, and vehicles the District owns or uses. This prohibition also extends to all outdoor areas located on school property. The District shall not allow the use of tobacco products during staff and training meetings.
