## Goals, Interim Goals, Professional Development Goals and Guardrails

### Goal 1:

Students scoring at proficient on the English Language Arts (ELA) of the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) assessment will increase from 43.3 % in grade 3 and 50% in grade 7 on July 27, 2020 to 83.3% in grade 3 and 90% in grade 7 on July 1, 2025.

### Interim Goal:

The percentage of students on track (performing at or above the 41st percentile on NWEA) in **reading** will increase from 67 % on September 15, 2020 to 73 % on May 15, 2021, in 3rd grade and from 69 % on September 15, 2020 to 75 % on May 15, 2021 in 7th grade from 67 % on September 15, 2020 to 73 % on May 15, 2021, as measured by NWEA MAPS assessments.

The percentage of students on track (performing at or above the 41st percentile on NWEA) in **language** will increase from 70 % on September 15, 2020 to 76 % on May 15, 2021, in 3rd grade and from 67 % on September 15, 2020 to 73% on May 15, 2021 in 7th grade from 72 % on September 15, 2020 to 78 % on May 15, 2021, as measured by NWEA MAPS assessments.

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## Goal 2:

Students scoring at proficient on Math of the SBAC will increase from 43.3 % in grade 3 and 48.1% in grade 7 on July 27, 2020 to 83.3% in grade 3 and on July 1, 2025.

### Interim Goal:

The percentage of students on track (performing at or above the 41st percentile on NWEA) in **math** will increase from 63 % on September 15, 2020 to 66% on May 15, 2021, in 3rd grade and from 51 % on September 15, 2020 to 56% on May 15, 2021 in 7th grade, 66 % on September 15, 2020 to 72% on May 15, 2021 as measured by NWEA MAPS assessments.

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## Goal 3:

Mastery of power standards in ELA and Math will be met by 95% of students that enter 9th grade and continue on to graduate from Lincoln County School District. Baseline data to be collect School Year 20-21

### Interim Goal:

The percentage of students on track to have mastery of power standards in ELA and Math will increase from 0 % on September 15, 2020 to 25 % on May 15, 2021, as measured by Empower LMS or Summit Learning.

## Professional Development Goals for FY 20-21

By the end of the 2021 school year, 100% of teachers will have participated in student-centered professional learning that is provided by Lincoln County School District and measured annually by increased student growth in RIT score all ELA and Math on the MAPS assessment.

By the end of the 2021 school year, 100% of courses taught in Lincoln County School District will have power standards, course descriptors, and syllabi to ensure students, parents, teachers and administrators all understand what and why students are learning as measured by increased student academic gain in all courses.

By the end of the 2021 school year, 100% of the educators in Lincoln County School District will provide high quality, data driven instruction through rigorous and relevant learning experiences aligned to standards as measured by increased student academic gain in all courses in all schools.

## Guardrails:

No student under 41%ile will go without tier 2 or 3 intervention in the subject of need.

Teachers will not be excused from district provided professional development.

Teachers will not use anything other than the student-centered competency-based platform in Empower LMS or Summit Learning.
